***A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
BLANCO-PEDERNALES GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
ADOPTING THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 (TAX YEAR 2026)***

WHEREAS, the Blanco-Pedernales Groundwater Conservation District (the "District") is a groundwater conservation district created in accordance with, and subject to, Chapter 36, Texas Water Code; and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized under Chapter 36, Texas Water Code, and the District's enabling documents to levy, assess, and collect an ad valorem tax at a rate not to exceed \$0.05 per \$100 valuation of taxable property in the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") has received the no-new-revenue tax rate and the voter-approval tax rate for Tax Year 2026, calculated in accordance with Section 26.04, Texas Tax Code, on the forms prescribed by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts and using the values shown on the certified appraisal roll furnished by the Chief Appraiser of the Blanco Central Appraisal District, the no-new-revenue tax rate being 0.015899 per 100 valuation and the voter-approval tax rate being 0.016679 per 100 valuation; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the proposed budget and fee schedule for Fiscal Year 2027 and finds the tax rate adopted herein to be necessary to fund the maintenance and operations of the District and to satisfy the fiscal requirements of the District's budget; and

WHEREAS, because the tax rate adopted herein does not exceed the no-new-revenue tax rate, no public hearing on the tax rate is required under Section 26.06, Texas Tax Code, and no disclosure statement under Section 26.05(b), Texas Tax Code, is required in connection with this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, any member of the public desiring to address the Board regarding the adoption of the tax rate was afforded the opportunity to do so at the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted, in accordance with Section 551.007, Texas Government Code:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Blanco–Pedernales Groundwater Conservation District that:

Section 1. The Board hereby adopts the ad valorem tax rate for Fiscal Year 2027 (Tax Year 2026) in the amount of \$0.015899 per \$100 valuation of taxable property in the District.

Section 2. The tax rate adopted herein does not exceed the no-new-revenue tax rate; accordingly, the adoption of this Resolution was not subject to the hearing, notice, record-vote, and supermajority requirements of Sections 26.05(b) and 26.06, Texas Tax Code. Nevertheless, the vote on this Resolution was taken and recorded in the minutes of the meeting of the Board held on September 10, 2026, reflecting the vote of each director present.

Section 3. The tax rate adopted herein is effective October 1, 2026.

Section 4. The General Manager is directed to publish and post the Notice of Adopted Tax Rate (Comptroller Form 50-883) as required by Section 26.05, Texas Tax Code, and to certify the adopted tax rate as required by Section 26.15, Texas Tax Code, to the Blanco Central Appraisal District.
