Public Comment Period on Draft 2027 State Water Plan Now Open

Public Hearing May 27

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) public comment period on the [Draft 2027 State Water Plan](#) is now open, and comments will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 29.

The draft plan was developed using a two-phased approach to meet the 2026 State Water Implementation Fund for Texas (SWIFT) commitment deadline, while also preserving additional time to produce a more robust final plan by the statutory deadline of January 5, 2027.

The initial draft document provides a streamlined set of core elements required by statute and administrative rule. A subsequent enhanced version of the 2027 State Water Plan, the first amendment to the plan, is anticipated for completion in the fall of 2026 and will provide more expansive and informative content. That amendment will also include its own formal public comment period.

2. in person at a hearing scheduled for 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 27, in room 170 of the Stephen F. Austin Building (1700 North Congress Avenue, Austin); or
3. virtually at the public hearing on Wednesday, May 27, held online—information on how to attend can be found on the [TWDB website](#).
